Meadowpark School and Nursery welcomes all children irrespective of gender, ethnic origin, nationality, religion or disability.

The Headteacher is responsible for decisions relating to the admission of pupils into Meadowpark.

Our aim is to admit pupils with academic and other qualities such that the child would gain the maximum benefit from the opportunities available at Meadowpark. In assessing this, a number of factors are taken into consideration including, not in specific order, developmental, emotional and academic ability, siblings at (or previously at) Meadowpark, the date of registration for entry, previous attendance at Meadowpark Nursery School and other factors.

Meadowpark is an inclusive school and proud of the support and provision we give to pupils with Special Needs. In certain cases there may be an impact on staffing and resources so early inquiry is recommended in such cases. A policy on Accessibility for the Disabled is available on request.

Whether or not a place is offered rests with the Headteacher whose decision is final; when applicants exceed the available number of places it is inevitable that some applicants have to be disappointed. All offers of places are made in writing by the Headteacher.
